

USA Masters Games Participation Policy

The term “2017 USA Masters Games Participation” is defined broadly to include all individuals and groups included within “USAMG Constituents” as defined below. The USA Masters Games is open for participation to every person who meets the age, membership, or other pertinent requirements, if any, for any sport of, or position with, the Games as set forth on Sport Information Pages, volunteer or officials recruitment criteria, or similar information as contained on the USA Masters Games website www.usamastersgames.com.

The term “USAMG Constituents” is defined as including, but not limited to, USA Masters Games athletes, management and administrative staff, officials, medical personnel, volunteers, accredited media, venues and venue staff, sponsors, host hotels, vendors, contractors, subcontractors, exhibitors, entertainers, and any and all other organizations and persons affiliated with, involved in, and representing, the 2017 USA Masters Games.

The USA Masters Games values diversity and inclusion and does not discriminate against any person for any reason, including, but not limited to race, creed, color, national origin, ethnicity, age, gender, religion, sexual orientation, or sexual identity, and welcomes any and all adult athletes who meet the minimum requirements of the Games (as set forth above) to participate in, and enjoy, the Games.
